A commitment to health equity includes developing and enacting a community-centered and –informed collaboration process within Public Health Policy and Planning (PHPP). Informed by community, this could include providing a health equity academy to equip community in equity-centered advocacy. This process will be aligned with our internal leadership engagement with the community and will be developed in collaboration with community members, community agencies, staff, and stakeholders.

Jurisdiction Process Interviews	Learning best practices across jurisdictions on their community engagement processes and/or advisory boards.
PHPP Internal Leadership Interviews	Understanding the baseline of community engagement within public health and where there might be any gaps.
Working Group	Community leaders representing diverse racial/ethnic backgrounds and regions to help vet our engagement plan and help with the community interview process.
Community Dialogue	Diverse community groups will be engaged in dialogue around what authentic community collaboration processes look like to them and what topic might be of interest to help equip them in health equity discussions.
